

Changes to Golf Committee Structure

Golfing Members,

I am writing to inform you of the background to changes to our Committee Structure to be implemented at the Golf AGM on 15th November.

I have in the past few months had discussions with Club CEO Michael Alexander where he has expressed a desire, supported by the Board, to make some alterations to our committee structure and lines of communication with Club staff.

The changes will merge the Greens sub committee ,the Ladies sub committee, and the Executive committee. The Golf Club Manager will act as committee secretary and be our liaison with the CEO the Board, and staff.

The Club will also be taking over the control of the Cart Shed from December 1.

The new committee structure will be ;

President, Vice President, Mens Captain, Ladies Captain, Treasurer, 3 Male Members and 3 Lady Members.

The Ladies and Mens Captains will still require the support of a Ladies Match committee and a Mens Match committee.

As you are aware the involvement of our committee in the day to day running of Golf has all but ceased, the Pro Shop now has full control of all events and tournaments.

The Club does recognise the input from members is vital to the smooth running of events and the on going development of the course , and to that end has resolved to provide up to \$10,000 each year in order to continue our programme of course improvements, tree planting, support for Pennant golf and Junior development etc.

Members will be able to raise any concerns they have about the course with any committee member, minutes of committee meetings will be available for your scrutiny.

I am hopeful that with new Manager Tony and the new Committee we can enjoy a period of co-operation and growth for the benefit of the Golf Club and the Golfing Members.
