



Acting CEO Report

Hi Members,

We hope you are all keeping safe and well in these unprecedented times.

The border restrictions between Victoria and New South Wales has impacted heavily on our community and adjustments to cluBarham's trading have been implemented. With the current border permits allowing Victorian residents to access essential services and supplies only, this unfortunately excludes leisure activities such as a visit to the Services Club, Golf Club or utilising any of our sporting facilities. We understand and share the disappointment and frustration of our members and guests who are currently unable to use our great facilities.

The Barham Services Club is still open to our NSW members and guests, but due to the current border restrictions, trading hours have been adjusted. All our facilities are operating with COVID Safe Certification. The current Barham Services Club trading hours are as follows: Sunday to Thursday: Midday to 8:30pm
Friday and Saturday: Midday to 10:00pm

Also impacted is cluBarham Golf and Sports Club trading hours which are as follows:

Wednesday 9:30am to 2:00pm

Thursday 11:00am to 5:30pm

Saturday 10:00am to 5:00pm

Those with golf memberships can access the course outside of these hours also.

New South Wales residents are welcome to come in and enjoy Lunch, 7 days a week, Midday to 2:15pm and dinner 6:00pm to 8:00pm Sunday to Thursday

6:00pm to 8:30pm Friday and Saturday.

Between the hours of 2:15pm and 6:00pm, hot beverages and cake or slices can be ordered at the Main Bar.

Some great news is that even though our Koondrook members within the Border Zone are unable to visit our Club we can provide them home delivery of beverages (must provide proof of identification 18+) and also food. Please order either online or call club reception with credit card details.

All Club promotions are on hold at the moment, however the Bucket List Raffle tickets can be purchased online. Due to the previous closure from March until June, NSW Fair Trading has permitted us to extend the Bucket List Raffle that had a previous draw date on the 18th April, to a new draw date of Saturday 19th September 2020. 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Annual board elections will soon be upon us with nomination forms available from the Services Club from Monday 25th August 2020. This year in accordance with the Club Constitution there will be mandatory pre-election seminar training conducted by our Club Auditor, Mr Peter Rae. This training will be held at 5pm on Tuesday 15th September 2020 and is to ensure that all candidates can meet compliance and governance obligations and help improve operations and financial viability.

Nominations will close at 6pm on Wednesday 16th September 2020.

The current board has undergone some changes in recent months. Board members Graeme Hare, Annabel Barr and Ian Ellis have resigned from their positions. Bruce Venn has been invited back to the Board and accepted a casual vacancy until the upcoming elections. One Director Glenn Faul is standing down and is eligible for re-election a further two positions were vacated due to resignations under the Tri-Annual rule. There are an additional 2 one year terms to be filled.

This year, due to the Covid 19 restrictions being imposed on a significant number of the Club's members, the Board have passed a resolution that the 2020 Election of the Board will be conducted electronically by Vero Engagement & Voting Solutions Pty Ltd. All members will receive correspondence advising of the Notice of the AGM and the new voting procedures.
